GENERAL INFORMATION

the European Solidarity Corp project will start here in Lunaria, Rome, Italy, on the 01st of May 2022 and finish on the 31st of October 2022, for a total duration of 6 months. The organization will host two ESC volunteers from two different countries, that will stay for the same period.

Lunaria is located in via Buonarroti 39, Rome and some part of the activities will be run in the office of the association. While all the other part related to field activities could take place in different locations in Italy.



PROJECT OBJECTIVE

the European Solidarity Corp project aims to support the activities of the Mobility sector part of the organization. More specifically, through the project, our goals are:

- to promote intercultural learning and mutual understanding
- to promote peace and all the related values
- to fight against any type of discrimination, based on culture, language, religion, country of origin, gender, economical status and physical characteristics
- to promote the professionalization of youth work, favoring the exchange of non formal education methodologies and approaches among youth workers
- to favor the encounter and the exchange among young people coming from different countries and backgrounds of origins.

TYPE OF WORK

support to the activities of the Mobility sector, which implements Erasmus+ projects and mainly training courses and youth exchanges. More specifically the volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- relationships and communication with partner organizations
- recruitment, orientation and support of the participants involved
- field activities with different roles (e.g. logistic support, financial reporting support, facilitation of some non formal education workshops, international workcamps coordination)
- support to the financial reporting after the end of the activity
- activities for communication, visibility and dissemination

VOLUNTEERS PROFILE

- aged between 20 and 30 years old
- high motivation and interest
- good knowledge of English (written and spoken)
- possibly a basic knowledge of Italian
- possibly a basic knowledge of Erasmus+ activities as youth exchanges and trainings, as participants
- it's extremely welcome a basic knowledge of non formal education activities

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

in order to submit your expression of interest the following documents must be submitted within the official deadline of the 31st of March 2022:

- **Curriculum Vitae in English**
- **Motivation letter, including a specific section where are mentioned, if you had, your past experiences with Erasmus+ activities and your knowledge about non formal education**

DEADLINE: the deadline to submit the expression of interest is the 31st of March 2022 sending all the documents to the e-mail: scambi@lunaria.org, putting in the object "ESC candidature 2022".



BEAUROCRATIC ISSUES

- **Pocket Money:** volunteers will receive a daily pocket money of 5,00 € for each day of project, which corresponds to 150,00 € per month.
- **Food and lodgment:** the project will cover the food and lodgment costs through a monthly fee of 600,00€. Participants will directly receive the amount every month and will be in charge to identify, by themselves, the most suitable hosting solution in Rome. The association remains at disposal to support the volunteer, where needed.
- **Insurance:** volunteers are covered through the CIGNA insurance system for ESC. For more information, please refer to: <https://www.cignaglobal.com/> and to <https://www.cignahealthbenefits.com/>
- **Holidays:** volunteers will have 2 days each month of holidays. So in case of a 6 month project it will be 12 days of holidays. The exact dates to be arranged after an agreement with the organization
- **Linguistic support:** the volunteers can also benefit, where required, by the OLS. The Online Linguistic Support (OLS) has been designed to assist Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps mobility participants in improving their knowledge of the language in which they will work, study, or volunteer, before and during their stay abroad, in order to ensure a better quality of learning mobility.

TRAVEL COSTS

the travel costs to join the project and to be back home at the end of the project are fully covered by the Erasmus+ program and change according to the distance band.

Moreover, the volunteer has the chance to opt for the "green travel" using more sustainable and environmental friendly means of transport.
